Chikungunya Update: Chikungunya is a viral disease which is transmitted to humans by infected mosquitoes – including *Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus*. Symptoms appear between 4 and 7 days after the patient has been bitten by the infected mosquito and these include: High fever, Joint pain (lower back, ankle, knees, wrists or phalanges), Joint swelling, Rash, Headache, Muscle pain, Nausea, Fatigue. Chikungunya shares some clinical signs with dengue and can be misdiagnosed in areas where dengue is common.
